What is Automated Giving?

An alternate means of support for St. Patrick's instead of envelopes. In lieu of weekly collections, the ParishPay program will collect monthly contributions from your checking, saving, or credit card account. There is **NO** cost to participate in the program.

What are the benefits to me?

- ✓ Allows you to plan your giving, in the same way you budget your other financial commitments.
- ✓ You no longer have to be concerned about catching-up missed offertory donations when you miss a Mass because you are out of town, on vacation, ill, etc.
- ✓ You can easily adjust the amount of your automated contribution (up or down) through the Rectory or do it yourself via a secure website access.
- ✓ You no longer need to write a check every week.

How does it relate to the use of the weekly envelopes?

If you choose to participate in the Automated Giving Program, this will replace your weekly envelopes.

I feel uncomfortable not having something to physically drop into the collection basket. What should I do?

Special *donation* slips are available for those enrolled in the automated giving program to be dropped into the collection basket, should you wish.

What about Special Collections?

You can specify your giving level for Special Collections and special celebration dates (e.g., Christmas, Easter) when you join the Automated Giving Program, or anytime thereafter.

Parishioner's Guide to ParishPay: Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How do I enroll?

A. Enrollment is easy and free. You can enroll by:

1. Signing up directly on the ParishPay website at www.parishpay.com,
2. Go to www.stpatrickinarmonk.org and click on the **ParishPay** icon
3. Sending the attached enrollment form to the Rectory at:

4. Filling out an enrollment form at the rectory,
5. Calling 866-PARISH-1.

Q. Can I contribute to second collections including both parish and diocesan collections?

A. Yes, all automated giving participants have the opportunity to contribute to second and special collections at the parish, including Christmas, Easter, Peter's Pence and more.

Q. How does a parishioner change his information, such as the amount of his/her donation, bank account number or mailing address?

A. The parishioner can provide these changes to the church office or rectory or directly by visiting the website at www.parishpay.com.

Q. Which payment methods are accepted?

A. Automated transfers from your checking, savings accounts or major credit cards such as American Express, Visa, MasterCard, and Discover may be used to make monthly contributions, one-time gifts, and pledge payments.

Q. Does the parishioner receive receipts for tax purposes?

A. Yes, all contributors enrolled with ParishPay can print out an annual receipt directly from the website every January, which they can use as documentation for the IRS.

Q. Can I donate a one-time gift or pledge for a specific term?

A. Yes, one time gifts are graciously accepted. Participants can also arrange for a specific amount to be paid over a number of months.

Q. Can a person sign up for automatic contributions even if he is not already registered with that parish or residing within the parish boundaries?

A. Yes. All stewards are encouraged to enroll.
